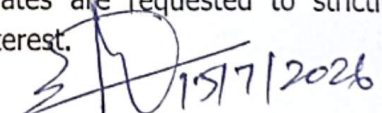

PRESS RELEASE

NO. PSC/ADMN./2026/1433: All aspirants (Differently Abled Persons) who have applied against the Disability Quota are hereby informed that the facility of a helper/aide during Examination shall be provided only to eligible candidates after due verification of their disability-related documents, in accordance with Regulation 58-A of the Sindh Public Service Commission (Recruitment Management) Regulations, 2023, and subject to fulfillment of following requirements:

1. Candidates possessing a valid Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority certifying permanent blindness, amputation of both upper limbs, or any other permanent disability that prevents them from holding a pen or, in the case of a Computer-Based Test (CBT), from reading the screen and operating the keyboard/touchpad, shall be eligible for the facility of a helper/aide.
2. Eligible candidates shall submit a written application, addressed to the Controller of Examinations, requesting the provision of a helper/aide at least three (03) days prior to the commencement of the examination.
3. Requests for the provision of a helper/aide submitted at the Examination Centre or at the time of the examination/test shall not be entertained.
4. During the Examination, at the time of verification, candidates shall produce the following original documents:
 - o Original valid Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority; and
 - o Original Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC) issued by NADRA.
5. The Commission shall verify whether the candidate has applied under the Disability Quota. The facility of a helper/aide shall be provided only to those candidates who have applied against the Disability Quota and fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria.
6. In absence of the Commission's prior approval or failure to produce the required original documents, no helper/aide or any other special assistance shall be provided at the Examination centers.

The Commission advises all concerned candidates to ensure the timely submission of their applications along with the requisite supporting documents to avoid any inconvenience. Candidates are requested to strictly comply with the above instructions in their own interest.
